### **Life Group Discussion Questions**

1. When Elijah speaks to the Lord on Mt Horeb (Sinai), he claims that he is the last person in Israel who follows the Lord. But reading in 1 Kings 18 and 19, who else should Elijah have recognized as a true follower of God?
  1. Why do you think we typically feel like we are the only one that suffers a certain way or certain trials as Christians?
  
2. Elijah seemed to be upset and scared that Queen Jezebel was threatening to murder him in 1 Kings 19. It seems that he was hoping that God would either smite them or cause the people to rebel against Ahab and Jezebel. However, what do we see in 1 Kings 19:15-19 that shows Elijah that he should have trusted the Lord in regards to Ahab and Jezebel? (Hint: read 1 Kings 22 and 2 Kings 9)
  
3. Elijah was not the only person in the Bible who suffered despair and depression. Do a word search on despair and see what other people in the Bible suffered in the same way.
