Life Group Discussion Questions

- The six points of application from the text are:
 1. When you worship - don't come empty handed - read Deuteronomy 16:16-17
 2. When you worship - crush what you bring - read James 1:17
 3. When you worship - anoint what you bring - read 2 Corinthians 1:21
 4. When you worship - make your heart a sweet aroma to God and to others - read 2 Corinthians 2:15
 5. When you worship - be seasoned with much salt - Luke 14:34
 6. When you worship - place only dead things on the altar - Romans 12:1-2

- 1. Moses is writing this book for the "next generation" of Israelites (those who did not come out of Egypt and had been born in the wilderness).
 1. What challenges is this new generation going to face?

 2. Why do you think that this book helps those who are about to enter the promised land? Think about how their world will change.

- 2. What are some practical examples of each of the above points? i.e. give an example of what each one might look like as we gather together as a church.

- 3. Thinking about each of the points in turn:
 1. which ones are the easiest? Which ones are the hardest?

 2. What barriers exist that might prevent people from doing these?
